BOGDANOV ALEKSANDR NIKOLAEVICH (Born in Kiev, 1908)

Bogdanov was a talented Moscow artist. From 1927 to 1930 he studied in VKhuTeMas – VKhUTeIN, at the All-Union Art Workshops (Institute in Moscow) under the tutelage of I. I. Mashkov, A.A. Osmerkin, K. Istomin, S. Gerasimov and D.P. Shterenberg. Bogdanov's graduation work "Red Army soldiers are skiing" was acquired by the Tretyakov State Gallery. Since 1931 Bogdanov constantly participated in major art exhibitions. His works can be found in the Tretyakov State Gallery and in many art museums of the former USSR as well as in The Museum of Russian Art ("TMORA") in the USA.
