Kabanov Viktor Pavlovich (Russia, 1924)

People's Painter of the USSR. Born in Saratov 1924. Studied at Saratov Art College under I.N. Shcheglov till 1948, then in Moscow Institute of Applied and Decorative Arts (1948-1952) under V.G. Odintsov, Moscow State Art Institute named after V.I. Surickov under P.I. Kotov. Active in Moscow. Began exhibiting 1957. important shows include "Soviet Russia", Moscow, 1960. Author of paintings dedicated to the reality of modern country life, portraits, and landscapes. Visited Virgin Lands repeatedly 1950s-60s. Well- known works include "the Virgin Land Lives" (1961). Taught at Art School in Phnom-Pen 1968-69. The artist's works are in many regional museums, in private collections in Russia and abroad.
