PROKHOROV KONSTANTIN ALEKSANDROVICH (born in 1924, Karavaevo)

Honoured Art Worker of the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic. Honoured Artist of the Russian Federation. He studied at Ivanovo Art College from 1940 to 1946. In 1948 he graduated from N. Samokish Art College in Simferopol. From 1949 to 1954 he taught in this college and at the same time he took distant education courses at Repin Institute of Painting, Sculpture and Architecture in Leningrad. From 1955 to 1958 he was the Head of the Crimean Regional section of the Union of Artists of the USSR and since 1989 Chairman of the military commission of the Moscow section of the Union of Artists. His one-man shows took place in Kiev, Sevastopol, Simferopol, Moscow from 2002 to 2005, in the Lower and Upper Chambers of the Russian Parliament in Moscow and in the Federation Council. Works by K.A. Prokhorov were acquired by the Ukrainian and Russian Ministries of Culture and can be found in Russian and Ukrainian museums. His works are also in many private collections in Russia, Great Britain, Japan, France, Poland, Czech Republic, Nigeria and regularly sold in European auctions.
