DERYAZHNY FEDOR IVANOVICH (born in 1914, Novye Sanzahry)

People's Artist of USSR in 1972. He studied at Kiev Art Institute from 1937 to 1947. Active in Kiev, Ukraine. He dedicated himself to the topics of Russian history and landscapes. He began to exhibit in 1947. His solo exhibitions took place in Moscow in 1968, 1970 and 1973, in Novosibirsk in 1957, in Austria in 1958, in Freiburg in 1959, in Baden and Stockholm in 1960 and in Kiev in 1967. He taught at Kiev College of Applied Arts from 1940 to 1950. He was also a tapestry artist. The works of the artist can be found in museums, galleries and private collections in Ukraine, Russia, Europe and the USA.
